Daytime Highs - in the 60s Yawn... lazy and waking up. Slow to grow Status Pre-Emergent goes down in spring and fall. Spray Super Juice in the 14-2-4 ratio as often as you want. Daytime Highs - in the 70s Status -Put down PGF granular fertilizer HUMIC DG can be applied anytime after 70s for new users apply twice per season. Spray Super Juice 14-2-4 ratio. Daytime Highs - in the 80s I am awesome... just try and stop me. Status Organic Fertilizer now can be applied Watch for Army Worms apply the new DOU at very first signs. Start Super Juice at the 7-1-2 ratio Daytime Highs - in the upper 80s low 90s I like this weather, I might retire here. Organic Fertilizer can be applied if needed Watch for Army Worms apply the new DOU Apply Super Juice after rains in the 7-1-2 Ratio at very first signs. Daytime Highs - in the 90s + It's hot out here, I'm going to chill. Status Apply Super Juice after rains in the 7-1-2 Ratio Watch for Army Worms apply the new DOU Apply in the early morning or late afternoon. at very first signs. Winter Good night... see you next spring.

Rather than trying to figure out soil temps or adjust months for your area, this chart allows you to use the day time highs which is often easier.
